

Fr. Mesrop Aramian
Chairman of the Board of Trustees of Ayb School

Biography

Fr. Mesrop Aramian was born in Yerevan on June 20, 1966. Fr. Mesrop is a graduate of [PhysMath School after Artashes Shahinyan at Yerevan State University](#). In 1990 he graduated from the [Moscow Institute of Physics and Technology](#) (MIPT) with a Master of Science degree in Engineering and Theoretical Physics. He successfully passed Lev Landau's "Theoretical Minimums" in 1995-1996 and joined Vitaly Ginzburg's theoretical physics group in 1998. He was ordained a priest of the Armenian Apostolic Church on May 28, 1991.

In 1991, Fr. Mesrop Aramian founded Gandzasar Theological Center and now heads it as Director and Editor-in-Chief.

In 2002, he founded [Vem Spiritual-Cultural Radio Station](#) and since has been its Editor-in-Chief.

In 2004, he created Vem Media Arts film production studio which he currently heads.

In 2006, in association with a group of friends, he established the Ayb Educational Foundation.

On November 6, 2013, he on a voluntary basis was appointed the Advisor to the President of Armenia on Education.

Presently Fr. Mesrop Aramian is the Director of the [National Program for Educational Excellence](#) (NPEE) (a program which was initiated by the Ayb Educational Foundation in collaboration with the [University of Cambridge](#) and [University College London Institute of Education](#)).

Since 2011 he has been the Chairman of the Board of Trustees of Ayb School.

Fr. Mesrop Aramian is married and has seven children.
